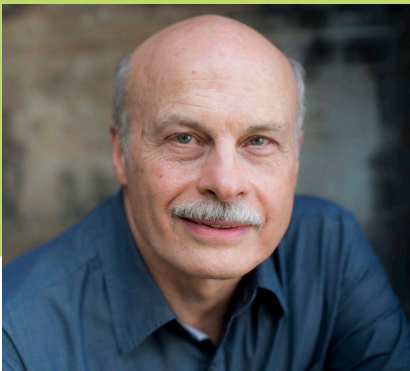

Matt Tyrnauer is an award-winning writer, journalist, and director whose films include *Valentino: The Last Emperor*, which was short-listed for an Academy Award for best documentary feature; *Where's My Roy Cohn?*, about the Svengali behind Joseph McCarthy and Donald Trump; *Studio 54*, about the famed New York City nightclub that became a cultural phenomenon; *Scotty and the Secret History of Hollywood*, about the secret history of sex in Hollywood in the pre-Stonewall era; and *Citizen Jane: Battle for the City*. His latest projects include *The Reagans*, a four-part documentary series for Showtime that re-examines Reagans' America and the impact of their politics, policies and beliefs on our society today, and the documentary series *Home*, for Apple.

Tyrnauer's upcoming projects include multi-part documentary series *The Rise and Fall of Victoria's Secret*, the dramatic adaptation of his *Vanity Fair* article *Once Upon a Time in Beverly Hills*, and the dramatic adaptation of *Scotty and the Secret History of Hollywood* with Fox Searchlight, written by Seth Rogen and Evan Goldberg and directed by Luca Guadagnino.

As a journalist, Tyrnauer has written for *Vanity Fair*, where he was editor-at-large and special correspondent. His work has also appeared in other publications including *GQ*, *The New York Times*, *Architectural Digest*, *L'Uomo Vogue*, and *Numero*.



Bob Eisenhardt is a filmmaker renowned for editing documentaries. He is an Oscar nominee, a four-time Emmy winner, and a two-time winner of the Eddie award from the honorary society of American Cinema Editors. He has over sixty films to his credit.

His film, *Spaces: The Architecture of Paul Rudolph*, was an Academy Award nominee for Best Short Documentary.

Bob edited *Free Solo*, the 2019 Oscar and BAFTA award winner, for which he received the ACE Eddie for Best Editing – Documentary. Other recent films include: *Scotty and The Secret History of Hollywood*, *Restless Creature: Wendy Whelan*, shown at the 2016 New York Film Festival, and HBO's *Everything is Copy: Nora Ephron, Scripted and Unscripted*, shown at the 2015 New York Film Festival, a Primetime Emmy nominee, and winner of ACE Eddie for Best Editing – TV Documentary.

Other films include *Wagner's Dream*, which received an Emmy nomination for editing, *Meru*, Sundance Film Festival audience award winner, *Valentino: The Last Emperor*, *Dixie Chicks: Shut Up & Sing*, *Living Emergency: Stories of Doctors Without Borders*, and *Concert of Wills: Making of the Getty Center*.

When not in the edit room, Bob teaches at the School of Visual Arts MFA Program and the thesis master class at the New York Film Academy.
