Responsibilities

Administration

- Lead & Manage staff
- Interface with the Board, Board members, and Board committees.
- Oversee and ensure the submission of all reporting requirements, annual Audits & Reviews
- Oversee the management of CDC properties

Strategic planning

- Develop and update a strategic plan for carrying out the mission of the CDC
- Develop and manage an annual budget for the organization
- Set goals for economic development programming
- Set goals for housing development
- Align Staffing with Organization's needs & goals

Outreach /Publicity

- Manage the profile of the CDC locally, regionally and state-wide
- Develop and oversee community engagement activities
- Maintain Community partnerships
- Direct/oversee all organizational communications: frequent press releases, monthly e-blasts, quarterly newsletter

Fundraising

- Oversee grant writing activities
- Oversee fundraising activities
- Maintain/grow local, regional, state and federal professional and funding relationships in community development and related fields

Housing development

- Oversee development projects
- Develop a pipeline of projects that extends out 5-7 years
- Engage with local and regional development partners
- Secure required approvals

Economic development

- Work with the Economic Development Committee
- Create and expand programs that support the regional small business community including expanding our Small Business Technical Assistance program (SBTA), the regional Entrepreneurs Forum, free Wi-Fi for the GB Downtown Corridor, and
- Promote civic programs including our Summer Music Festival and activities of the Downtown Cultural District.
- Oversee development of other projects such as open space park development and other “one-off” community projects
- Seek new opportunities to support the local economy
- Serve as a thought leader and collaborator to move projects from inception to implementation.
